CRAIG RICHEY is currently on the piano faculty at the Bob Cole Conservatory of Music at CSU Long Beach. A native of North Carolina, he received his high school diploma from the N.C. School of the Arts, his Bachelor of Music degree from the St. Louis Conservatory, and his Master's degree from the Juilliard School. Hailed by the St. Louis Post-Dispatch for his 'No-nonsense pianism!' he made his New York debut with pianist Pamela Mia Paul as guest duo-soloist with the New York Pops at Carnegie Hall. He has appeared both in solo and chamber music recitals throughout the United States. His performances have been aired on National Public Radio and Voice of America Radio, which is broadcast worldwide. He taught for ten years at the renowned Third Street Music School Settlement in New York City and directed their esteemed chamber music program. His major teachers include Joseph Kalichstein and Martin Canin.
