Dear Teachers and Parents:

We are looking forward to the participation of your student(s) in the SCJBF Complete Works Audition on Sunday, October 3rd at CSU Long Beach.

Directions to the CSULB campus, together with a map showing the layout of the Bob Cole Conservatory of Music will be uploaded to the SCJBF website. These are accessible on the public area of the site and may be downloaded and printed.

Parking is available in lot 12 and in the adjacent parking structure on Palo Verde Ave. Please note: The University has installed a License Plate Recognition parking system. Attendees of CWA must pay for parking at a machine in the lot. When purchasing the permit, the user must enter his/her license plate number.

Teachers: Please review the posted schedule for your student(s) on the scjbf.org website by logging in with your teacher credentials. Links are posted immediately above your Teacher Menu. Check spelling of names and contact me immediately if you see any errors so these may be corrected in the printed program.

Students should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their audition time. Please check-in at the registration desk located in the outside area in front of the Rehearsal Halls. Students must bring their music for the judges. **Photocopies or free downloads from IMSLP.org will not be accepted.** Repeats are optional but are not encouraged. **Accompaniment is required for concertos.** Teachers may **not** accompany their own students.

This year due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the performances will be held in a closed audition format (1 student at a time with 3 judges and 1 room monitor, no audience). Everyone is expected to wear masks and socially distance themselves. The CWA Winners' Lists will be emailed to the CWA teachers and posted on the SCJBF website. NO results will posted at the college. Please leave the campus immediately after student performances are completed. NO practice rooms will be available. Students should bring hand sanitizer to use before and after performing. Room monitors will frequently sanitize the keyboards.

Gold, Silver and Bronze medal winners will receive their medals during the Complete Works Awards Program on Saturday afternoon, October 16, 2021 at 2:00 PM. **The location for the CWA Awards Concert is Covenant Presbyterian Church, 607 E. Third Street (at Atlantic Ave.), Long Beach, 90802.** All students wishing to receive their medals should be present at this program. This is our chance to honor them for their outstanding work.
